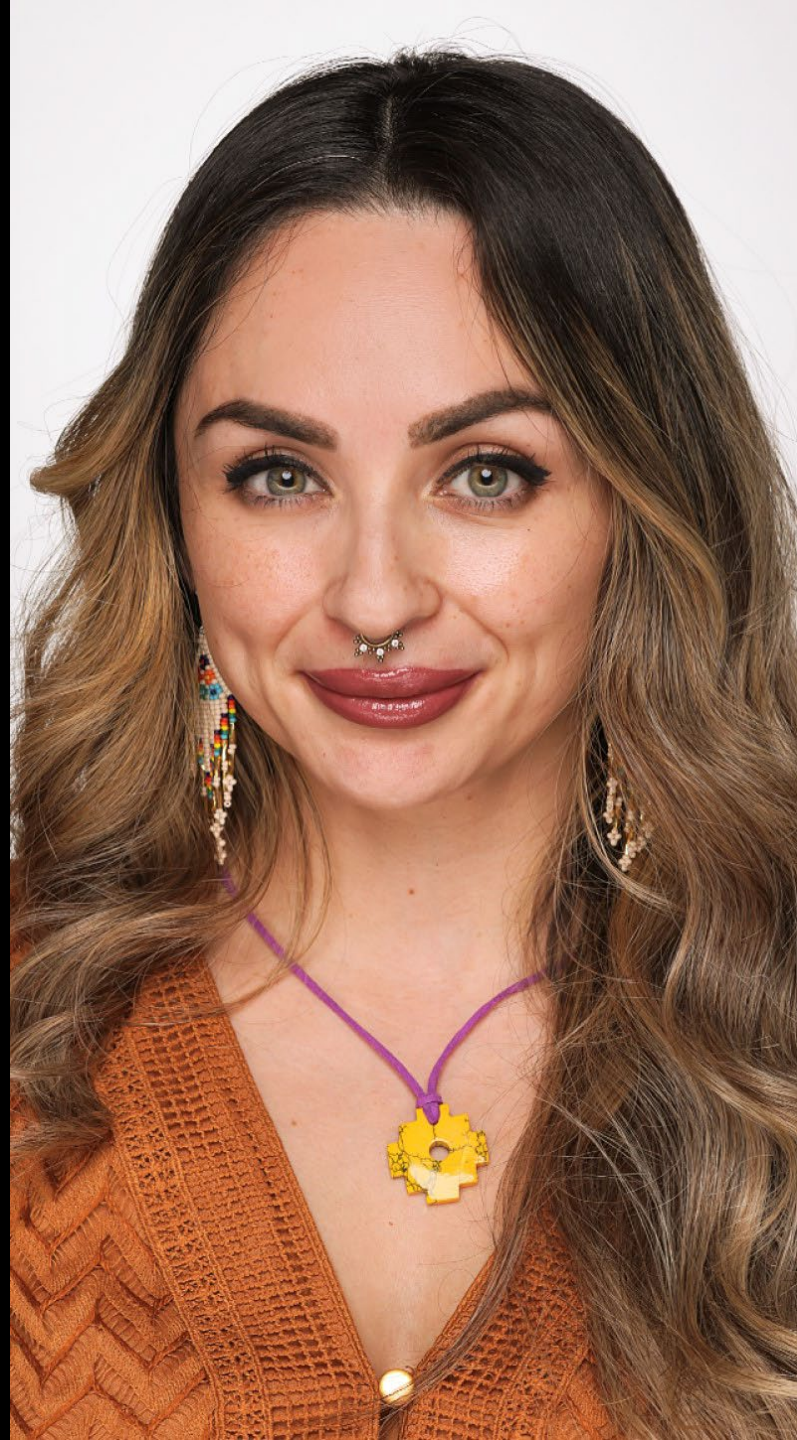
YVETTE MACHADO-TUINIER
