

# APPLICATION FOR UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION

## Application Deadlines:

Fall: Feb. 1 • Summer: Feb. 1 • Spring: Oct. 1

**Note:** To be assured full consideration, applications for admission should be received by the deadlines listed above. Completed applications will continue to be taken and considered up to six weeks prior to the start of the semester.

## Admission Requirements:

**A student who has attended high school *only*** must graduate with a minimum weighted grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale in the following core courses: four years of English, three years of social sciences, three years of natural sciences (two years must include lab sciences), and three years of mathematics (algebra level or higher).

**The minimum GPA for freshmen will increase to a 3.0 starting fall 2008.** If you have graduated or will soon graduate from high school and will not have obtained further education beyond high school, submit your final high school transcript and, if appropriate, your senior class schedule. **Transcripts must remain in the sealed envelope provided by your high school.** The Office of the Registrar & Admissions will make the first attempt to request Clark County School District transcripts from the last two years if high school ID number is provided.

**Transfer admission** is granted to those who complete a minimum of 24 transferable semester credits and earn a GPA of 2.3 or higher from a regionally accredited university or college. Students within this category are not required to provide their high school records. **The minimum GPA for transfer students will increase to a 2.5 starting in fall 2008.** If you have attended a regionally accredited college or university and have at least 24 transferable semester credits, your high school record is not needed. Submit transcripts from all postsecondary institutions attended and, if appropriate, your current class schedule. **Transcripts must remain in the sealed envelope provided by the issuing institution(s).**

**Students with fewer than 24 transferable credits** will be held to the freshman requirements outlined above and must have the minimum transfer GPA to be considered for admission. In addition, transcripts from both high school and all postsecondary institutions attended must be submitted. **Transcripts must remain in the sealed envelope provided by the issuing institution(s).**

## Test Scores:

Please provide an official test score report if you have taken either the ACT or SAT College Entrance Examinations. Test scores must be sent **electronically** or must **remain in the sealed envelope provided by the testing agency.** Test scores may be used in the admission process. Scores will be required for placement into English and mathematics courses and for scholarship consideration.

## Alternate Admissions:

If it is determined that you do not meet the minimum admission requirements, you may have the option to appeal the admission decision through the Faculty Senate Admissions Committee.

- If you have used any other names that may be on previous records, attach a note of explanation and proof of the name change(s).
- Make certain your Social Security number is correctly entered if available.

## International Students:

If you are an international student who requires a student visa (F-1) to enter the country, do not fill out this application. You must obtain an International Application for Admission available, at [www.unlv.edu](http://www.unlv.edu).

## After You've Applied

**Immunization Requirements**—State law requires that all newly admitted students submit proof of immunization before they may attend any classes. All students, regardless of age, must provide documentation of immunization within the last 10 years for tetanus-diphtheria (Td). Students born in or after 1957 must provide documentation for two doses of live measles (rubeola), one mumps, and one rubella vaccination. Send **copies** of these records to the Office of Registrar & Admissions prior to registration.

**Freshman On-Campus Housing Regulation**—UNLV requires freshman students from high schools outside Clark County, Nev., to live on campus during their first year. Apply early to secure your space and increase your chances of getting your room and/or floor preferences. **Financial Aid**—You are encouraged to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the UNLV scholarship application by the following priority deadlines:

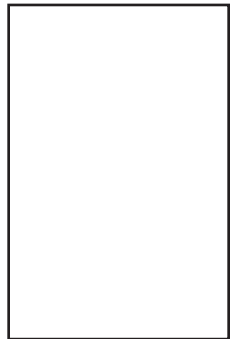
