


<p>H-1B: Temporary worker visa status, includes faculty, professional staff, and researchers</p> <p>J-1: Visiting researchers and professors, exchange and sponsored students</p> <p>J-2: Dependent of a J-1 who has work authorization</p> <p>TN-1: Temporary worker visa status for Canadian and Mexican citizens</p> <p>PR/I-485: Pending U.S. Permanent Residence ("Green Card")</p> <p>F-1 OPT: Student in F-1 status who has permission to work after completion of studies (Optional Practical Training)</p> <p>F-1 CPT: Student in F-1 status who has permission to work during his/her studies (Curricular Practical Training)</p>
