March 5, 2013 – The University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) Alumni Association is accepting nominations for the 2013 Outstanding Alumnus of the Year Award.

The award, established in 1974, is the highest and most prestigious award given by the association. It's designed to recognize an individual's impact on UNLV, through the significant contributions they've made to society in their professional field or through their personal achievements. The award is not based on accomplishments achieved during the current year but on contributions over their lifetime. The award recipient will have brought positive notoriety to the university through their personal and/or professional achievements.
