UNLV Named a Regional Solar Test Center



In order to qualify for financing, developers of new solar products, particularly those used for large photovoltaic projects, need to present operating data for those systems in the climate similar to where they will be used. The U.S. Department of Energy has established a set of five regional test centers (RTCs), where companies can contract with the D.O.E. to have their products evaluated; UNLV has been selected to manage one of these sites.
