Math and English Registration

All majors are required to take ENG 101, ENG 102, and a mathematics course. You must meet the minimum ACT/SAT test score in order to register for these courses. If you have not already satisfied these requirements, locate your test score in the chart below to see where you start in English and math.

English: If you are not able to go directly into ENG 101, you will need to take a developmental English course. ENG 101E & F are two courses taken over two semesters. Completing the series will give you credit for ENG 101 and an open elective. If you do not meet the minimum score for this series, you must take ENG 098 which is also offered by our local community college – the College of Southern Nevada (CSN).

Math: All majors in the College of Hotel Administration are required to take MATH 124. Gaming majors take an additional math – MATH 132. If you are not able to go directly into your required math class, you will need to start with the developmental math course for which you qualify, and then proceed on until you complete the required math course. MATH 095 and 096 are also offered by our local community college (CSN). Please note that MATH 120 does not satisfy the requirement for majors in the College of Hotel Administration.

Note that these developmental courses do not count toward full-time enrollment at UNLV. Be sure to consider this when meeting with your academic and financial aid advisors. It is a good idea to get these courses done prior to your first semester at UNLV.
