Membership and Dues

Any full-time, part-time, undergraduate and/or graduate social work student at University of Nevada, Las Vegas who meets the qualifications set forth in the By-Laws shall be eligible for active membership.

Membership dues will include thirty-dollar (\$30.00) lifetime chapter dues in addition to the required National Phi Alpha membership dues. National dues are subject to change with or without notice.

Each member of Phi Alpha Delta must maintain Grade Point Average (GPA) standards throughout the academic year.

Each member must participate in a minimum of ten (10) hours of organization-recognized community outreach per year (September-June) to be considered an active member. Failure to do so will result in involuntary withdrawal from Phi Alpha Delta Honor Society membership. Refund of membership dues will not be permitted. Community outreach hours may be combined with UASWS required service project/activities hours.

Members will be allowed one (1) vote in any and all general and/or special called meetings.

Membership in Phi Alpha, Delta Chapter, includes membership in UASWS for the first year.
