The **UNLV CHORAL ENSEMBLES** enjoy a reputation for excellent performances throughout the southwest and beyond. Under the direction of conductors David B. Weiller and Jocelyn K. Jensen, the choirs (University Concert Singers, Chamber Chorale, Varsity Men's Glee Club and Women's Chorus) present several concerts annually on the university campus and in the greater Las Vegas community. Tours have encompassed Nevada, California, Arizona, Utah and Colorado, as well as itineraries in Hawaii, New York, Mexico and Canada. Notable highlights include appearances with the world renowned Boston Pops Esplanade Orchestra and a massed choir performance in New York City's Carnegie Hall.

The **WOMEN'S CHORUS**, established in 1992 by Jocelyn K. Jensen to meet the needs and interests of a growing musical campus, performs a wide variety of exciting choral repertoire written specifically for women's voices. The chorus includes students, faculty, staff, alumni and community members of all ages. "We come together from every walk of life. There are accountants, students, teachers, domestic engineers and engineers. We are salespeople, hotel workers, nurses and waitresses. We are young and very young, older and, yes, even older than that! We share a love for singing and an understanding of the uniqueness of women in this complex society." The choir appears each year at "Take Back the Night" sponsored by the UNLV Women's Center as well as at several other concerts on campus.

The **VARSITY MEN'S GLEE CLUB**, founded in 1987, emphasizes great music making in an atmosphere of camaraderie with university students, faculty, staff, alumni and community members. The men begin most performances by jogging raucously onto the stage, followed by their traditional theme song, "We Meet Again Tonight." Varsity Men's Glee Club has performed for regional and national festivals sponsored by Intercollegiate Men's Choruses and has also appeared at many university and civic events in Las Vegas.

The UNLV Choral Ensembles maintain an active student chapter of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA) that supports choral music and special student projects. The chapter has hosted the ACDA Western Division Student Symposium numerous times on the UNLV campus, including this fall on November 8-9. The choirs also sponsor **LAMPROPHONY**, a student-organized contemporary *a cappella* ensemble that performs on campus and in the community.
