**\*\*Courses in red must be a grade of a B or higher. All other courses not requiring a B or higher from the above list will require a C or higher. Courses that require a grade of B have a maximum of two attempts including a withdrawal or audit grade.**

### Credit Requirements:

Student must complete a minimum of 122 credits to graduate

Student must complete a minimum of 60 credits at a four year institution

Student must complete last 30 credits in residency

### Program Policies:

G.P.A. must be 3.0 or above needed to apply for BSN degree

Effective January 2012: differential tuition was implemented for all BSN students.

HESI A2: you have two attempts to obtain a passing score of 75% or above in all areas

BIOL 223 or BIOL 224 grade of B or higher must be posted on MyUNLV to request permission to enroll in NURS 299.

The last grade received for all courses at any institution will be the final grade of record.

**English Proficiency Test** – Students who are non-native English speakers must provide official test score for TOELF iBT demonstrating proficiency to the Health Sciences Advising Center. Acceptable score is **100 points** or above. This is the only acceptable English proficiency test.
