AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR Hospitality Entrepreneurship Association

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is "empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN"; AND

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate for the needs of undergraduate student organizations; AND

WHEREAS, the student organization has completed all of the necessary documentation as required by the Ways and Means Committee and the Ways and Means Operating Policy; AND

WHEREAS, the Hospitality Entrepreneurship Association provided a budget to be included under *Addendum A*

WHEREAS, the CSUN Ways and Means Committee will review the Hospitality Entrepreneurship Association request on 11/21/2023 during WM 54-01; AND

WHEREAS, the student organization, after being seen by the Ways and Means Committee, has been approved for an amount not to exceed \$750.00;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, CSUN shall appropriate \$750.00 one-time to fund the Hospitality Entrepreneurship Association and where all costs are to be encumbered from the CSUN FY 23 Student Organization Funding Budget in adherence with the Ways and Means Operating Policy.
