SENATE BILL 54-11

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR Student Technologist Association in Radiological Sciences

Sponsor of Legislation: CSUN Ways And Means Committee

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate for the needs of undergraduate student organizations; **AND**

WHEREAS, the student organization has completed all of the necessary documentation as required by the Ways and Means Committee and the Ways and Means Operating Policy; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Student Technologist Association in Radiological Sciences provided a budget to be included under *Addendum A*; **AND**

WHEREAS, the CSUN Ways and Means Committee will review the request on November 21, 2023 during WM 54-01; **AND**

WHEREAS, the student organization, after being seen by the Ways and Means Committee, has been approved for an amount not to exceed **\$5,580.47** ;**AND**

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, CSUN shall appropriate **\$5,580.47** onetime to fund the Student Technologist Association in Radiological Sciences and where all costs are to be encumbered from the

CSUN FY24 Student Organization Funding Budget in adherence with the Ways and Means Operating Policy.
