SENATE BILL 54-56

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CSUN BYLAW CHAPTER 1205

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; AND

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is "empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN"; AND

WHEREAS, edits to the CSUN Bylaws are necessary to improve the functionality of productivity of the CSUN UndocuNetwork Sponsorship; **AND**

WHEREAS, the CSUN UndocuNetwork Sponsorship shall award UNLV undergraduate students with the renewal amount in accordance with the renewal amount set by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services; AND

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED

SECTION 02: FUNDING

A. Starting with the fiscal year in which the sponsorship is passed, and every following year thereafter, CSUN shall disburse \$20,000 (twenty thousand) to UndocuNetwork.

- 1. \$10,000 shall be used for the purpose of compensating members for their time and trainings they have provided to UNLV and high school staff, professors, administration, student government representatives, teachers, counselors, students, departments, organizations, etc through the DREAMzone program.
 - i. The funds for the DREAMzone trainers will cover the majority of a two hour-- DREAMzone 1(one)-3 (three) hours-- 2 (two) or 3 (three) presentations per month presented by one to three members of the UndocuNetwork; Plus, potentially 1 (one) DREAMzone training per semester if such training is requested by the UNLV community or high schools.
- 2. \$10,000 shall be used for the purpose of distributing fee waivers for DACA Renewal Application expenses.
 - i. The funds for the DACA Renewal Fee Waivers will cover the full amount for each DACA renewal application (\$495 per recipient) (Recipients will be awarded the renewal amount based on the type of DACA renewal application and the costs set by United States Citizenship and Immigration Services).
