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# Why a UNLV School of Medicine?

- + Will educate **60 students** a year at start, then **120 when building done up to 180** per year
- + Will recruit **more than 120 faculty** to educate students and residents
- + Will be developing a partnership academic health center model with UMC, VA, Sunrise and Dignity systems
- + Will build research programs in key areas



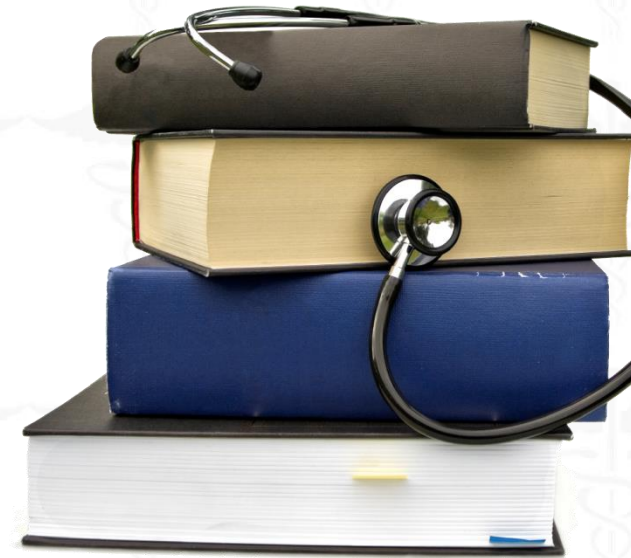
# Vision for UNLV School of Medicine

To develop a world-class center for education, patient care, and research that prepares Nevada's doctors with the most innovative and technologically advanced forms of medical training while serving the healthcare needs of a diverse and urban population through community partnerships.

# Key Areas for Development

Build clinical, educational, & research programs in:

- + Cardiology
- + Mental Health & Addiction
- + Neuroscience
- + Cancer
- + Orthopedics



# Scholarship Goal

- + Scholarships for each student in the first class for full four year tuition
- + \$100,000 each
- + So far we have 52 of 60 scholarships
- + The 60<sup>th</sup> scholarship will be for anyone in the community to support at any level
- + Goal is to get the very best possible class and keep them in Nevada





# Exciting Curriculum

- + Start by becoming certified EMT
- + Virtual anatomy (no dissection) and virtual microscopy (no microscopes)
- + Coroner's office experience (CSI)
- + Medical Spanish for everyone
- + Full year of outpatient medicine in a multispecialty, primary care home practice
- + Incorporate practices of hospitality in healthcare into student and patient experience

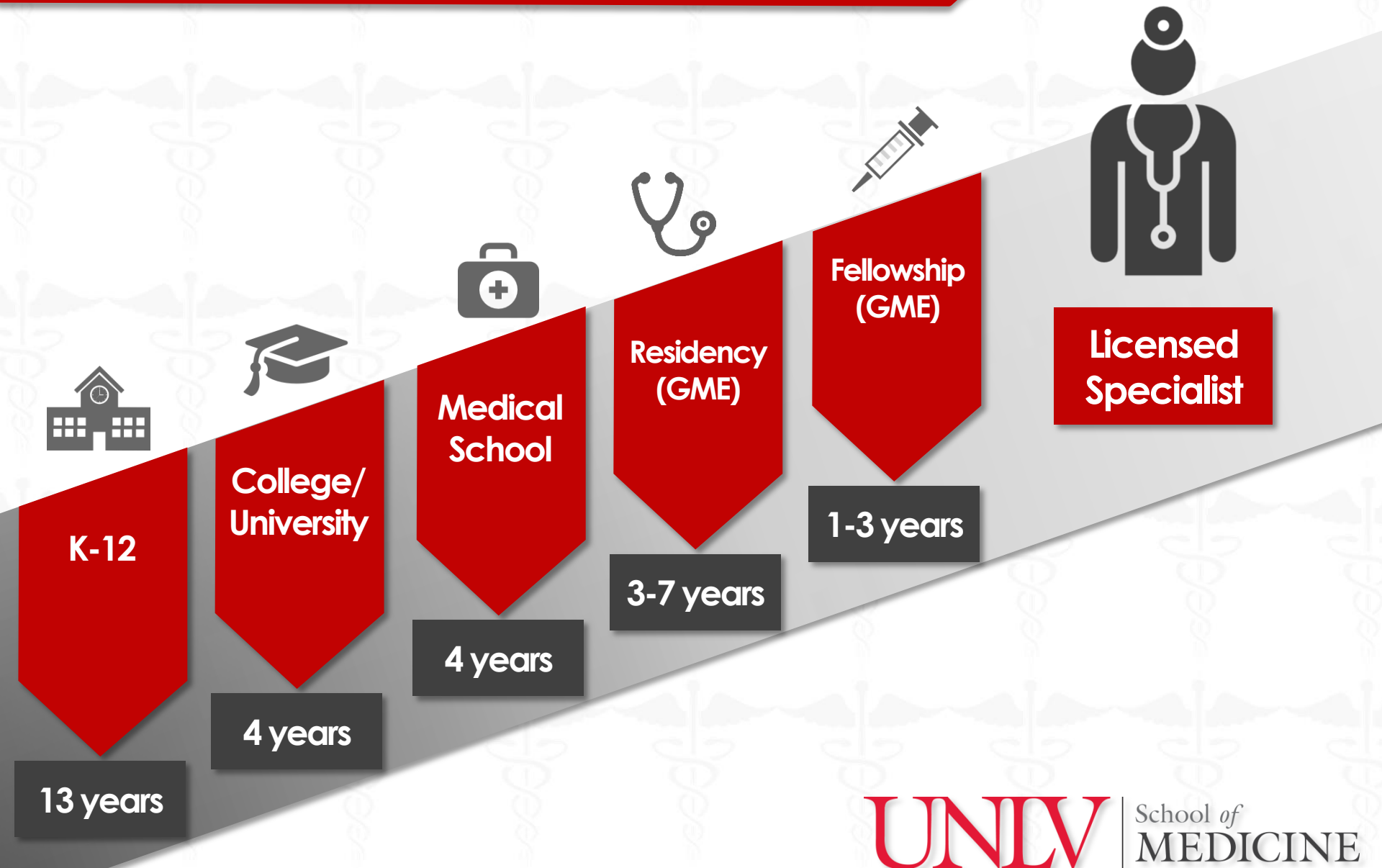






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# Timeline for Physician Training



# Why both GME & UNLV School of Medicine?

- + NV needs to increase the total number of residents in all areas: primary care, specialties, and subspecialties
- + Need additional faculty to teach residents/students in **more specialties than currently exist here**
- + Need programs to **keep graduates in NV**

# State Budget Requests

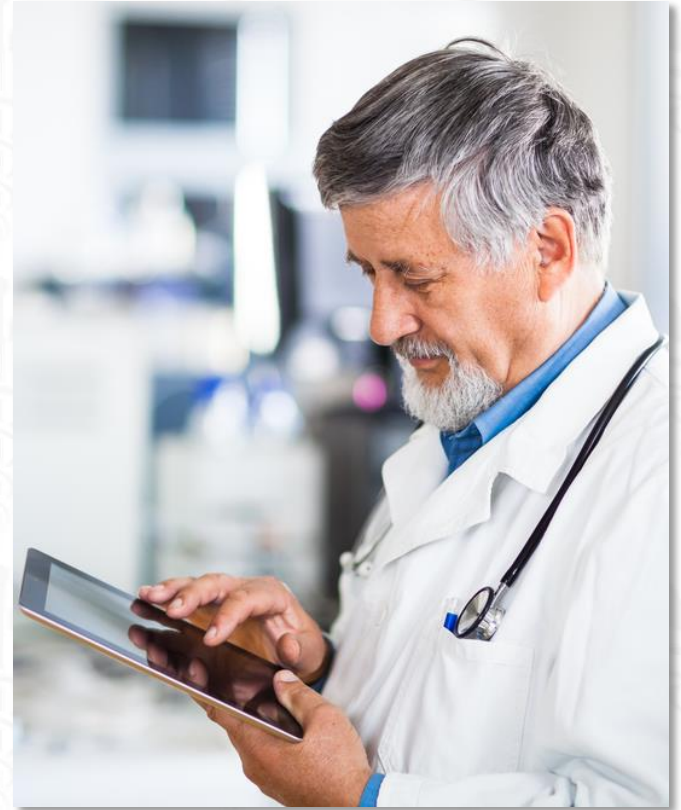
- + Regent's request, start first class 2017:
  - \$7.1 M first year
  - 19.6 M second year
- + Governor's proposal, start first class 2018:
  - \$1.3 M first year
  - \$7.1 M second year
- + Request at full build out in 2025:
  - \$45 M per year

**We hope to have the full Regent's budget restored**



# By 10 Years, UNLV will:

- + Be fully accredited
- + Graduate 180 students
- + Recruit at least 120 faculty
- + Increase physicians staying & practicing in NV



# By 10 Years, UNLV will:

- + Have generated **5,300** new jobs
- + Have at least **\$800M** economic impact/year
- + Generate direct revenue of **over \$250M/year**
- + Generate **\$4 for every \$1** of state investment/year
