

Age composition of eligible Voters, 1980-2060






### **Diversification of US Senior Electorate**




## Obama Won the Unmarried Vote

### Percentage of the Vote by Marital Status



Vote Percentage for Romney by Percent of Population 15 and Older Currently Married 2012


