## **UNLV Communication Studies Appeal Form**

What follows is the form for requests to the Communication Studies department regarding our undergraduate program at UNLV. Common reasons you may complete this form include:

- 1. Requesting special permission to enroll in a course (e.g., taking a course prior to completing the pre-requisite)
- 2. Requesting to enroll in an independent study (COM 495)
- **3.** Requesting that a course "count" for credit in Communication Studies (e.g., transfer credit hours, study abroad, another department)
- **4.** Any other exceptions to a COM department policy (e.g., grade exceptions)

Prior to completing the form, we recommend that you meet with an advisor from the college to discuss if the form is needed and to update your degree worksheet.

In addition to information shared in this form, depending on your request, you may also be required to submit any of the following:

- 1. Your most recent completed degree worksheet
- 2. Your most recent advising notes
- **3.** If you are asking to count a class from another institution, please include your transfer transcript
- **4.** If you are asking to count a class from outside UNLV, please include a copy of the syllabus for that course

If you are requesting to enroll in an Independent Study (COM 495), you must meet the criteria listed online. You must also attach a proposal that fulfills the following criteria:

- 1. Identify the instructor with whom you intend to work
- 2. Indicate the number of credit hours (1-to-3) you seek to complete,
- 3. Include a 2-4 page narrative that addresses such matters as
  - What you will study and the origins of the project in relation to previous course work
  - The project's scholarly rationale
  - The work's possible outcomes
  - Potential for development
  - An annotated bibliography of published works that help define the student's point-of-entry into the scholarly conversation/s to which the project might contribute

We also encourage you to read our departmental FAQs page, which highlights our general rules and policies regarding course permissions. If you have any remaining questions please reach out to the Communication Studies main office for assistance.

In the summer expect a longer delay for petition review, however during the Fall and Spring semesters petitions will typically be reviewed within 2 weeks. Once reviewed, the undergraduate student coordinator will email you, copying the advising center, to inform you of the decision.
