

Advanced Certificate of English Proficiency (ACEP)

The Advanced Certificate in English Proficiency consists of 15 credits in English language studies, with 12 credits in required courses and 3 credits in elective courses. This program may be completed in one semester. Completion of ACEP with a grade point average of 3.0, along with instructor recommendations, may result in a waiver of the TOEFL or MTELP for undergraduate majors.

Certificate of Academic Proficiency (CAP)

The Certificate in Academic Proficiency in English consists of 15 credits in high-advanced English language studies, with 12 of the credits in required courses and 3 credits in elective courses. This program may be completed in one semester. Completion of this certificate with a GPA of 3.0 results in a waiver of the TOEFL or MTELP for undergraduate majors.

Admission Requirements

Students who want to earn certificates in English Language Proficiency must first take the Michigan Test of English Language Proficiency (MTELP). A score of 50 on the MTELP is required for admission to the Intermediate Certificate in English Proficiency. A score of 60 on the MTELP or completion of the High-Intermediate Certificate in English is required for the Advanced Certificate in English program. Possible transfer credit and course substitutions will be determined by the Director in accordance with University policies.

The intermediate certificate in English proficiency consists of 15 credits in English language studies, with 12 credits in required courses and 3 credits in elective courses. This program may be completed in one semester.
