On behalf of the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities, I am pleased to report that the accreditation of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas has been reaffirmed on the basis of the spring 2005 regular interim evaluation report and visit, on a review of new University Centers, and on previously approved substantive changes regarding new programs in Physical Education, Information Systems, Public Administration and Crisis and Emergency Management.

In taking this action, the Commission requested that the University of Nevada, Las Vegas prepare a focused interim report and host a Commission representative in fall 2007 to address Recommendation 2 of the spring 2005 Regular Interim Evaluation Report. For your convenience, a copy of the recommendations from the evaluation report is enclosed.


