Community Partnerships Pathway Goal

The Community Partnerships Committee will develop principal actions in conjunction with the Top Tier Goal for Community Partnerships and provide input to the Office of Community Engagement. Select members will be involved with the Executive Committee and Community Steering Committee.

Executive Advisory Board

The Executive Committee will consist of the Director of the Office of Community Engagement, one member from the executive administration of UNLV, one member of the Top Tier Leadership Team, and elected members from the UNLV and Community Steering Committees. The Executive Committee will meet quarterly. The Executive Committee will review quarterly community engagement reports and set the priorities for the Office and committees.

UNLV Advisory Board

The UNLV Steering Committee consists of campus stakeholder representatives. The committee holds regular meetings and is responsible for providing input into the Office of Community Engagement Strategic Plan. Members are responsible for:

- communicating with stakeholder constituents and representing their interests on the committee;
- developing and implementing systematic community engagement reporting mechanisms across all facets of the university;
- developing and implementing a university-based action plan to carry out the work of the Office of Community Engagement; and
- identifying and addressing barriers to facilitate community partnership efforts across the campus.

Community Advisory Board

The Community Steering Committee will consist of representative community stakeholders. The committee will hold regular meetings and be responsible for providing input into the Office of Community Engagement. Members will be responsible for:

- communicating with community stakeholder constituents and representing their interests on the committee;
- developing and implementing systematic UNLV community engagement reporting mechanisms across all facets of the community;
- developing and implementing a community-based action plan to carry out the work of the Office of Community Engagement; and
- identifying and addressing barriers to facilitate community engagement efforts across all community sectors.
