

Advanced Program

The “Advanced Program” allows qualified UNLV undergraduate students to apply credits earned in approved MA classes toward their undergraduate degrees, including minors in economics.

Qualified undergraduate students are required to enroll in two MA classes. Students are required to enroll in ECO 740, Mathematical Economics, in their senior year. They may also enroll in one of the following courses: ECO 770 Econometrics I, ECO 701 Microeconomics and ECO 702, Macroeconomics. Advanced Program students who receive grades of B or higher in both MA courses can complete the Economics MA degree with 24 credits.

UNLV undergraduates must meet all of the following criteria to be eligible for the Advanced Program:

- Senior standing
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Completion of the following courses with a minimum 3.5 GPA and no grade lower than B: ECON 262 or ECON 441; ECON 302; ECON 303 and MATH 181
- Department chair or graduate coordinator’s recommendation
- Submission of two letters of recommendation and a completed Enrollment Request form to the Economics department no less than two weeks before the beginning of the semester for which they would like to register for graduate courses
