Entrance requirements: Students must meet and maintain the School of Nursing minimum GPA requirement of **2.50** for the Pre Nursing major. <https://www.unlv.edu/nursing/admissions>

Minimum Requirements For Application:

1. Completion of all prerequisite courses or enrollment of last remaining prerequisite courses listed on Pre Nursing worksheet.
2. A minimum cumulative **3.0 GPA** is required to apply to the Nursing program. If no UNLV GPA has been earned then the cumulative GPA from all other schools attended will be used.
3. A minimum "**B or higher**" within **two (2) attempts** is required for MATH 120 or 124, BIOL 223, BIOL 224, BIOL 251, and NURS 299. Withdraws "**W**" and Audits "**AD**" count as attempts.
4. A minimum "**C or higher**" is required for all other courses listed.
5. A review of your prerequisite courses must be completed by an academic advisor prior to confirm eligibility. Call (702) 895-5448 to schedule an appointment.

Note: Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee entrance into the School of Nursing BSN program.

Application Process Once Min. Requirements Are Met:

1. An application into the Nursing program is required.
2. Complete the **HESI A2 Entry Exam** with a **minimum 75% or higher** in all subject areas within **two (2) attempts** (Anatomy & Physiology, Grammar, Reading Comprehension, Math)
3. Students must apply **a semester in advance** to starting the BSN program. Students can only apply **twice (2)** to the BSN program.
 - February** for Summer admission
 - June** for Fall admission
 - October** for Spring admission
4. Attend a **BSN signing session** to formally apply. Call the advising center main office (702) 895-5448 to schedule.
5. HESI A2 exam **must** be completed before your BSN signing session.
6. Students are ranked on a point system by a calculation worksheet.
7. **Top 48** students are selected every term based off the total points received on the calculation worksheet. **88 points minimum** to apply.
8. These 48 students will be accepted into School of Nursing BSN program which will begin the following semester.
9. Once admitted into the BSN program, students will be considered Nursing majors and the designation will change from PRN to NURS.
10. Nursing students will complete additional 60 credits of the full major BSN program (16 months accelerated).
11. After completing the BSN program, students will take the National Council Licensure Exam-RN (NCLEX-RN).
12. Passing the NCLEX-RN is required to practice nursing in the United States.
