 2. Completion or enrollment of prerequisite courses (double asterisk ** courses).
 3. A minimum cumulative **2.50 GPA** is required to apply to the Radiography program. If no UNLV GPA has been earned then the cumulative GPA from all other schools attended will be used.
 4. A review of your prerequisite courses must be completed by an academic advisor prior to confirm eligibility. Call (702) 895-5448 to schedule an appointment.
- NOTE:** Meeting minimum requirements does **not** guarantee entrance into the Radiography program

Application Process Once Min. Requirements Are Met:

1. An application into the RAD program is required.
2. Applications are accepted every Spring semester in the month of Feb.
3. Student must meet with the Radiography Program Director.
4. Complete a hospital site visit.
5. Complete and submit application by the last business day in Feb.
6. **Top 24** students are selected to start the RAD program the following semester.
