*Admission to the first year programs of the School of Architecture is open to all UNLV students.

*Admission to School of Architecture second year studio programs is competitively based on a student's GPA and successful completion of first year studies.

*Before a student may enroll in upper-division courses, each student must gain approval by the Faculty Review Committee. Admittance to upper division is based upon a faculty review of:

- Successful completion of all required courses in lower-division studies and a minimum of 3.00 grade point average
- Completed School of Architecture Application for Upper- Division form;
- A portfolio of creative work;
- A written statement describing your professional interest and career development opportunities

The application deadline for AAD program is March 15 of each year. ARC and LAND deadlines are the first Monday after spring semester final exams week. Each application is checked for compliance with the minimum requirements prior to ranking by the review committee. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

*All lower-division design studios must be taken in sequence.

*Upper-division students in the School of Architecture design programs are required to complete a 200-hour internship with a professional design firm.
