Entrance requirements:
 Students must meet and maintain the Department of Kinesiology & Nutrition Science minimum GPA requirement of **2.50** for the Pre Nutrition Major. <https://www.unlv.edu/kns/nutrition/admissions>

Minimum Requirements For Application:

1. Completion of all prerequisite courses.
2. A minimum cumulative **2.75 GPA** is required to apply to the Nutrition program. If no UNLV GPA has been earned then the cumulative GPA from all other schools attended will be used.
3. A minimum "**C or higher**" within is required for MATH 124, BIOL 189, CHEM 108, BIOL 223, BIOL 224, and BIOL 251.
3. A minimum "**B or higher**" is required for NUTR 223, NUTR 271 and NUTR 301.
4. A review of your prerequisite courses must be completed by an academic advisor in the Health Sciences advising center prior to confirm eligibility. Call (702) 895-5448 to schedule an appointment.

NOTE: Meeting minimum requirements does **not** guarantee entrance into the Nutrition program.
**In the healthcare profession, fingerprinting will be required*

Application Process Once Min. Requirements Are Met:

1. An application into the DPND program is required.
2. Application is every **Spring** semester in the month of May.
3. You must attend a Nutrition signing session in the month of May to formally apply. Call the advising center main office (702) 895-5448 to schedule.
4. Students are ranked by cumulative GPA and prerequisite GPA and by a letter of intent.
5. **Approximately 50 students** are selected every year. This number is subject to change.
6. These students will be accepted into DPND program which will begin the following Fall semester.
7. Once admitted into the DPND program, students will be considered Nutrition majors and the designation will change from NUTRPRE to NUTR.
8. Nutrition students will complete additional 61 credits of the full major DPND program, which will take exactly 2 years to complete.
9. After completing the DPND program, students will able apply for, become accepted into, and complete an Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND) — Accredited Dietetic Internship.
10. Students need to pass the National Registration Examination for Dietitians in order to become a Registered Dietitian/Nutritionist (RDN). Starting 2024, a Masters in Nutrition will be required.
