 A minimum of 9 credits towards this minor must be earned at UNLV.  
 12 credits towards this minor must be upper-division (300 level or higher courses).  
 No more than 12 credits taken for the minor may be used to satisfy requirements in a student's major.  
 18 credits towards this minor must be earned within the subject area.  
 \*When multiple options are listed, the student may choose between either course option to satisfy minor requirements.
