C or better grade is required for all courses that apply towards any minors within the College of Sciences.

2.000 or higher cumulative UNLV and minor GPA is required to complete any minors within the College of Sciences

2.500 or higher cumulative UNLV GPA is required to declare a minor within the College of Sciences.

Students are ineligible to pursue two programs of study within the same department. Consult with your advisor for more information.

## Department Policies Regarding This Minor:

A minimum of 9 credits towards this minor must be earned at UNLV.

12 credits towards this minor must be upper-division (300 level or higher courses).

No more than 12 credits taken for the minor may be used to satisfy requirements in a student's major.

18 credits towards this minor must be earned within the subject area.

\*When multiple options are listed, the student may choose between either course option to satisfy minor requirements.

**\*\*MATH 127 or higher & CHEM 121A+L courses do not apply to minor requirements; however, they are required pre-reqs. for GEOL 220.**
