Application Process Once Min. Requirements Are Met:

1. An application into the RAD program is required.
2. Applications are accepted every Spring semester in the month of Feb.
3. Student must meet with the Radiography Program Director. An updated degree sheet from an advisor is required.
4. Complete a hospital site visit.
5. Complete and submit application by the last business day in Feb.
6. **Top 24** students are selected to start the RAD program the following semester.
