- Some courses within the program may interchange between GEOL and GEOG abbreviations. Either area will satisfy degree requirements.
- Some courses within this program are only offered in a specific semester once per year. Be mindful of course sequencing.
- C or better is required in EES core courses and GEOL or GEOG upper division electives.
- Upper-division courses are 300-400 level; courses below 300 level will not be accepted.
- MATH/STAT Choice: Choose from MATH 182 or STAT 152 or STAT 491. All pre-requisites for option selected must be met.
- Writing Choice: Choose from the following options: ENG 407A; ENG 405B; ENG 407B; ENG 407C. If course permission is required, contact 702-895-3533.
- 19 credits in Additional Electives & Other Topics are required. It is recommended that 6 of the 19 credits selected are upper-division to meet university requirements. C or better in GEOL/GEOG prefix courses required; S/F courses are ineligible. Courses that satisfy another requirement within the same major (such as general education courses) cannot double dip in this section.
- 2.000 or higher cumulative UNLV GPA is required for graduation.
- Consult advisor for transfer policies prior to taking courses at another institution.
- 120 total credits needed for graduation.
 - 60 credits must be earned from a 4-year school.
 - 40 credits must be upper-division (300-400 level).
 - Last 30 credits must be earned at a NSHE institution.
