Credit Requirements: Student must complete a minimum of 122 credits to graduate. Student must complete a minimum of 60 credits at a 4-year institution. Student must complete last 30 credits within NSHE residency.

Program Policies: G.P.A. must be 3.0 or above needed to apply for BSN degree, HESI A2: Two attempts to obtain a passing score of 75% or above in all areas. Students can only apply four (4) times to the BSN program, students must have a min. score of 88 points on Admissions calculation worksheet. The last grade received for all courses at any institution will be the final grade of record.
