Minimum Requirements for Application:

1. Completion of prerequisite courses (all double asterisked (**)) courses). These courses require a **C or higher** grade.
 2. A minimum cumulative **2.75 GPA** is required to apply to the Ultrasound program. If no UNLV GPA has been earned then the cumulative GPA from all other schools attended will be used.
 3. A review of your prerequisite courses must be completed by an academic advisor prior to confirm eligibility. Call (702) 895-5448 to schedule an appointment.

Minimum Application Process Once Min. Requirements Are Met:

1. An application into the Ultrasound program is required.
2. Applications are accepted **every Spring** semester in the month of Feb.
3. Complete and submit application by the last business day in Feb.
4. Applicants will complete an interview with the program director.
5. Top 10 students are selected to start the Ultrasound program the following Fall semester (5 alternates - approx.).
