### Composition and Conversation

- GER 213 – Intermediate German I
- GER 214 – Intermediate German II
- GER 301 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Year German: Composition and Conversation I
- GER 302 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Year German: Composition and Conversation II
- GER 401 – Advanced German I
- GER 402 – Advanced German II

Depending on language placement, students can follow one of these 200-level Composition and Conversation sequences:

- GER 213 and GER 214 OR
- GER 214 and GER 225

### Notes

- Requirements for a minor in German include 18 credit hours in the discipline.
- Must have an overall 2.0 GPA or higher in minor courses.
- At least 9 credits must be earned at UNLV.
- At least 12 credits must be upper division (300-400 level).
- Study Abroad courses are reviewed on an individual basis – see your advisor.
