Program Specific Information: Special grade rules: all degree-applicable courses must be completed with 'C' or better, except for EDEL 311/313/481 which require 'B' or better

Full major= 2.0 GPA; completion of 15 cr.; EDU 201 or 202 completed with 'C' or better; signed Praxis Core/CBEST Acknowledgement form submitted.

REMIINDER: Overall 2.75 GPA required to begin student teaching and to remain in good academic standing

6cr of college-level math can include any 100-level or higher math, except for MATH 115. MATH 122/123 strongly encouraged.

Humanities requirements can be fulfilled by any humanities from two different subject areas. NV licensing requires 6cr social studies. Can fulfill these 6cr through constitution requirements, humanities (HIST), GEOG, GEOL, PSY, SOC, PSC, ECON.

PRAXIS CORE EXAMS/CBEST EXAMS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR MAJOR, BUT STILL REQUIRED FOR NV LICENSURE

The requirements for the Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education degree are identical to the requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education degree with the exception that for the B.A., students must successfully complete two courses in the same foreign language.

Note: Some courses that fulfill specific general education requirements at CSN may fulfill different general education requirements at UNLV. Please see a UNLV/CSN Transfer Program Advisor to confirm your choices.
