Must include the following:

 - PHIL 242 – Ethics for Engineers and Scientists
 - PHIL 245 – Contemporary Moral Issues
 - PHIL 249 – Environmental Ethics
 - PHIL 311 – Professional Ethics
 - PHIL 345 – Health Care Ethics
 - PHIL 446 – Social and Political Philosophy
 - PHIL 450 – Ethical Theory
- Two additional upper division (300-400 level) philosophy courses

Notes

- Requirements for a minor in Philosophy include 18 credit hours in the discipline.
- Must have an overall 2.0 GPA or higher in minor courses.
- At least 9 credits must be earned at UNLV.
- At least 12 credits must be upper division (300-400 level).
