- 1. An application into the RAD program is required.
- 2. Applications are accepted every Spring semester in the month of Feb.
- 3. Student must meet with the Radiography Program Director (702-895-

- 4. Complete and submit application by the last business day in February.
- 5. Top 24 (approximate) students are selected to start the RAD program the following semester.
