**Entrance requirements:** Students must meet and maintain the School of Nursing minimum GPA requirement of 2.50 for the Pre Nursing major.

#### Minimum Requirements for Application:

1. Completion of all prerequisite courses or enrollment of last remaining prerequisite courses listed on Pre Nursing worksheet.
  2. A minimum cumulative **3.0 GPA** is required to apply to the Nursing program. If no UNLV GPA has been earned then the cumulative GPA from all other schools attended will be used.
  3. A minimum **"B or higher"** within **two (2) attempts** is required for MATH 124, BIOL 223, BIOL 224, BIOL 251, and NURS 299. Withdraws **"W"** and Audits **"AD"** count as attempts.
  4. A minimum **"C or higher"** is required for all other courses listed.
  5. A review of your prerequisite courses must be completed by an academic advisor prior to confirm eligibility. Call (702) 895-5448 to schedule an appointment.
- Note:** Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee entrance into the School of Nursing BSN program.

#### Application Process Once Min. Requirements Are Satisfied:

1. An application into the School of Nursing is required.
2. Complete the HESI A2 Entry Exam with a minimum **75% or higher** in all subject areas within **two (2) attempts: (Anatomy & Physiology, Grammar, Reading Comprehensive, Math)**
3. Students must apply one semester in advance of starting the BSN program. Students can only apply **four times (4)** to the BSN program:
  - February for Summer admission
  - June for Fall admission
  - October for Spring admission
4. Attend a **BSN signing session** to formally apply. Call the advising center main office (702) 895-5448 to schedule.
5. HESI A2 exam must be completed before your BSN signing session.
6. Students are ranked on a point system by the Nursing Calculation Worksheet.
7. Students must have completed **50 or more credits** of PRN prerequisites at UNLV to receive Rebel Recognition 1/2 point.
8. **Top 72** students are selected every term based off the total points received on the calculation worksheet. **88 points minimum to apply.**
9. These 72 students will be accepted into School of Nursing BSN program which will begin the following semester.
10. Once admitted into the BSN program, students will be considered Nursing majors and the designation will change from PRN to NURS.
11. Nursing students will complete additional 60 credits of the full major BSN program (16 months accelerated).
12. After completing the BSN program, students will take the National Council Licensure Exam-RN (NCLEX-RN).
13. Passing the NCLEX-RN is required to practice nursing in the United States.
