### **Outcomes Overview**

- We updated and prepared the New Faculty Orientation course in WebCampus for 305 new faculty members in four tracks: Academic Faculty Full-Time, Administrative Faculty, Chairs & Directors, and Academic Faculty Part-Time.
- We offered a five-week online course for faculty on Career Readiness, which was filled to capacity with 50 faculty participants.
- We sponsored a variety of mentoring groups and learning communities that met regularly in order to support a sense of connectedness for faculty. These groups are led by Faculty Center Fellows – see the 2022-23 cohort listed on page 5.
  - Mentoring groups for tenure track and part-time instructors
  - o Book group on Active Learning Online
  - o Faculty learning community on place-based learning
  - First-Year Experience discussion group
  - A writing group that checked in regularly for accountability and productivity
- For the first time, we offered a campus nature walk with mindfulness practice.
- Funded by a CAEO grant, we began a series of workshops on cultural competencies in STEM. We had a panel of faculty from Engineering and Science talk about inclusive practices, and a workshop on creating an inclusive syllabus.
- A Faculty Center fellow organized an off-campus field trip to Vu Technologies Studio, where faculty members had an opportunity to socialize and see a new tech opportunity in Las Vegas.
- Faculty Center Fellows offered 9 teaching observations and individual consultations.
- We participated in the UNLV team that was accepted to the <u>AAC&U Institute on Open</u> Educational Resources.
- We assembled and led the selection committees for the Distinguished Teaching & Regents'
  Award. We engaged past award-winners in this process, and selected outstanding faculty
  members for recognition.

- In addition to events planned and hosted by the Faculty Center, we co-sponsored and/or advertised many other events for campus units including The Intersection, Online Education, the Graduate College, and Office of Research and Sponsored Programs.
- The Faculty Center provided meeting space for Chair's Success, Leadership Experience, Accreditation Committee, Advising Lunch & Learn, Academic Council, and many other groups. In total, Faculty Center spaces were used 258 hours in Fall 2022.
- We send a weekly newsletter on Sunday nights and other occasional messages. Average open rate for the weekly newsletter is around 66%.
- Most faculty members who used Faculty Center services were Assistant Professors (26%) or Faculty-in-Residence/Lecturers (19.6%).
- All academic units (colleges and schools) were represented at Faculty Center events and services, most from Liberal Arts, Education, and Fine Arts.

## **Future Directions**

- We are part of a \$1.5 million AANAPISI grant awarded to CAEO and will continue our series
  of speakers on cultural competencies in STEM through the 2022-23 academic year, funded
  by that grant.
- We will update the Faculty Center website with more teaching resources, working with OIT and Online Ed. The Faculty Center website will become the hub for all teaching resources.
- We are also working with OIT and Online Ed to use RebelLearn for registration and evaluation of all faculty development activities.


