 - Completion of all PRECRJ courses (ENG 101, CRJ 104 and CRJ 270)
 - 2.0 GPA in at least 30 credits

Notes

- Must earn a minimum of 120 total credits.
- Must earn a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- Minimum 30 credits earned at UNLV.
- 42 credits must be Upper Division level (300-400 level), including 27 Upper Division credits in CRJ courses.
- Last 30 credits must be in residency as a declared major.
- Only transfer credits in which the student has received a C or better will apply toward the 48 CRJ requirements.
