

Career Opportunities - IS

Bachelor's in Information Systems

The job opportunities for professionals in the information systems industry are flourishing. According to data collected by Temple University in 2022, annual salaries for individuals with a bachelor's degree ranged from \$69,345 for someone working as an IT Auditor to \$82,197 for an Information Security Analyst. Other job categories include IT consulting, project managers, systems analysts, data and analytics and software developers.

Master's in Management Information Systems

The most abundant job opportunities for an individual with a master's in information systems are in the areas of application developer, IT consultant, and data/analytics. Annual salaries range from \$72,113 to \$110,077 with project manager positions paying the most. Master's salaries for Software Application Developers have grown 69% since 2013.
