

PI Eligibility Exception Assurance

If an exception has been granted for you to serve as Principal Investigator, then the chair or dean must be listed as a Legacy Co-PI on your proposal. This is to ensure audit compliance beyond the close out period and required period of record retention.

While serving in the PI role at UNLV you agree and certify that:

- a. The academic unit in which you are associated with and where you will conduct research or other sponsored activities must provide space and access to other research facilities, and accept responsibility for ensuring administrative support and budgetary control needed to effectively manage the project through the term of the contract or grant;
- b. The work will be conducted in accordance with the high standards of quality of all PIs;
- c. You will comply with all University policies relating to the conduct of research; and
- d. The research project will be conducted consistent with all sponsor regulations, NSHE policies and procedures, if applicable, and federal laws, rules and regulations relating to the conduct of research; and
- e. If employment terminates prior to the end of the project, the Legacy Co-PI will be responsible for completing the reporting and scope of work until the project ends.

If you accept these terms as PI, you acknowledge and agree to the responsibility as stated above and by signing below is your concurrence.
