involvement on campus and gain valuable skills that I will utilize in the future. I also want to put myself out there more and increase my engagement with the UNLV community.








Amber Cabras

I applied to the Rebels R.I.S.E. Scholar Program because I thought it would be a great opportunity to be more involved on campus and connect with other people.








Ainston McTyre

I applied for this program because I want to continue doing well academically in college, but also to work on good study and mental health habit, as well as meeting more people and having more fund with school events and activities!








Ariana Cruz




Caryl Roque

My goal for this semester is to increase my involvement on campus and in the surrounding community, so I applied to the Rebels R.I.S.E Scholar Program.








Colton Benedict

I applied to Rebels R.I.S.E. to open myself up to others more and meet like-minded individuals that I can build long-lasting relationships with on and off-campus.








Devyn White




Keilly Guevara

I applied to the Rebels R.I.S.E. Scholar Program for a new opportunity to develop and grow as a student and person while involving myself more into the Rebel community!








Lauren Flores






Sierra Magdaleno




Sydney Abella

I applied to the Rebels R.I.S.E. Scholar Program because I wanted to be more involved, learn valuable skills through events, and meet new people.








Tam Tran




Tanya Martinez
