


APA TITLE PAGE. (7TH EDITION)

TITLE PAGE

These are general guidelines for APA Title Pages. Check with your instructor for preferred formatting.



- Use 1" (2.54 cm) margins on all sides. For the page header use ½" margins and Times New Roman 12-pt font.
- The running head (sometimes omitted if your professor permits) is a short form of the title, no more than 50 characters, all in caps. Page numbers are flush to the upper right corner of page.
- The title is centered and double spaced. The title should be no longer than 12 words.








AUTHOR NOTES (IF REQUIRED)

The following format is for professional publication submissions.



- An author note (if required) will be included on the title page, double-spaced in Times New Roman 12-point font.
- Author notes are usually optional. However, they are often used when a writer is trying to publish their paper.
- The author note is split into four paragraphs:
 - **First paragraph:** ORCID iDs (if applicable)
 - Second paragraph: Changes of affiliation (if any)
 - Third paragraph: Disclosure and Acknowledgements
 - Fourth paragraph: Contact Information
