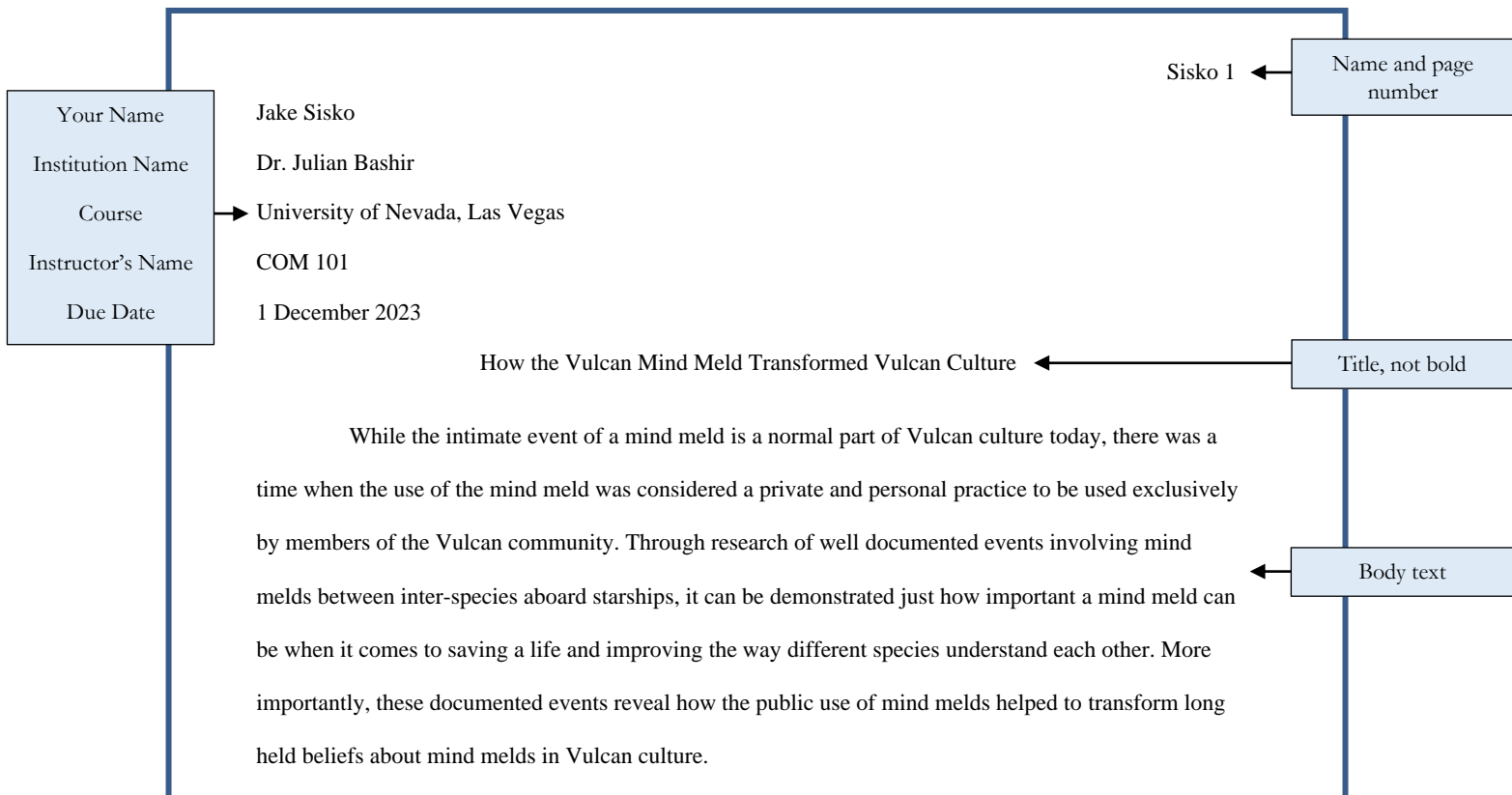


MLA TITLE PAGES

This handout gives you the basic guidelines for how to set up the opening page of a paper using 8th and 9th editions of MLA format and the title page of a group project using MLA 9th edition format. Be sure to refer to any requirements from your instructor before following the format here.

FIRST PAGE FORMAT



- Use 1" (one inch) margins on all sides
- Put your last name and page number in a heading .5 inch from the top of the page on the right side
- Include your full name, the instructor's name, the course, and the date on the left side, double-spaced, as shown above
- Center the title
- Double space all lines and do not add extra line spacing around the headers or title
- Use the same font, in the same size, and do not use bold or italics for the title

Title, not bold

- Use 1" (one inch) margins on all sides (you do not need a header)
- Include each student's full name, the instructor's name, the course, and the date on the left side, double-spaced, as shown above
- Center the title in the middle of the page
- Use the same font, in the same size, and do not use italics or bold for the title
