

# 'Budgeting for a GA' Calculator

Welcome to the step-by-step guide on how to budget for an **extramural** graduate assistant position when using your own worktag (account number). By the end of this document, you should have a clear idea of how much a graduate assistant will cost for your department.

Graduate assistants are either state funded or extramurally (externally) funded. The Graduate College allocates state funds to academic deans to hire state funded GAs, while extramural GAs are funded by sources outside of the Graduate College, such as grants, contracts, CGRAs, CIGAs and departmental/non-academic units on campus. State funded graduate assistantships are not subject to the same calculation measures as extramurally funded graduate assistantships. The following GA Calculator is only intended to calculate extramural graduate assistant packages.

The four factors considered to fund an extramural graduate assistantship are **stipend**, **fringe benefits**, **tuition**, **and fees**. The Graduate College processes health insurance and out-of-state tuition and fee waivers.

Please use the following steps to calculate the budget for a graduate assistant package.

# Step 1. GA Stipend

A stipend is a monthly monetary payment that GAs get in exchange for their work similar to a paycheck. The factors that determine the stipend amount include what kind of graduate student the candidate is, what department is awarding the GA position, and how the position is funded. Please see the GA stipend website to check the current stipend amount offered by your department.

The general guidance for GA stipend amounts are as follows:

Master's minimum stipend for TWO SEMESTERS: \$17,000 Master's minimum stipend for ONE SEMESTER: \$8,500

**Doctoral** minimum stipend for **TWO SEMESTERS**: \$22,000 **Doctoral** minimum stipend for **ONE SEMESTER**: \$11,000

# Step 2. Fringe Benefit

The graduate assistantship package must account for a fringe benefit, which is 13.3% of the GA stipend.

# Step 3. Tuition

Tuition rates are calculated per credit. The tuition rate is subject to change, so please check the table below for the rate that corresponds to the academic year of your graduate assistant package.

All graduate assistants from out-of-state receive a non-resident tuition fee waiver. This means they receive in-state tuition costs. The Graduate College processes the waivers.

Graduate assistant packages include tuition costs for up to nine credits. Master's students typically receive the full **nine credits** per semester, while doctoral GA packages typically cover **six credits** per semester. Please consult appropriately to determine how many credits your department wishes to include in the graduate assistant package.

# Step 4. Fees
