- Students must meet and maintain the Greenspun College of Urban Affairs minimum GPA requirement of 2.00 for admission into the <u>School of Social Work</u> Pre-major Program.
- Upon completion of PRESW requirements with a 2.5 GPA or higher, students must apply to the BSW program (see <u>department undergraduate admissions</u> website for further instructions).
- Must be admitted to the BSW Program to take additional SW courses.

#### Notes

- Must earn a minimum of 120 total credits.
- Must earn a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- 42 credits must be Upper Division level (300-400 level)
- Last 30 credits must be in residency as a declared major.
- A minimum grade of C or higher (C- is not acceptable) is required in all SW courses, Additional Requirements, and MATH 124 to meet the degree requirements. Note: MATH 121 does not meet the math requirement for this major.
- Strongly prefer ECON 180: The Economics of Discrimination, but will accept ECON 102, 103, 104, or 190.
