Section 1: Background and Instructions

Background: The U.S. Department of Education recognizes that there are instances in which a student may have unusual circumstances. A student may indicate they have an unusual circumstance by selecting "Yes" to Question 7 on the FAFSA form. Unusual circumstances refer to the conditions that justify an aid administrator adjusting a student's dependency status based on a unique situation more commonly known as a dependency override.

Students who were granted a dependency override in 2024-25 or the current academic year by the UNLV Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships will not need to re-appeal the following academic year unless the student indicates their situation has changed or our office has encountered conflicting information. However, students must complete the 2025-26 FAFSA form to be considered for federal and institutional aid to have their unusual circumstance appeal renewed.

Instructions: Please upload the completed form, provide a detailed explanation of the circumstances, and all supporting documentation to the <u>Rebel Success Hub</u> at unlv.today/Rebel-Success.You will be notified of the review/decision through your case in the Rebel Success Hub. Please allow up to 15 business days from receipt of your <u>completed</u> appeal for our office to carefully review your appeal.

The following instances are deemed by the U.S. Department of Education (ED) to not justify a change in dependency status either alone or in combination:

- Parents refuse to or are unable to contribute to the student's education;
- Parents will not provide information for the FAFSA or verification:
- Parents do not claim the student as a dependent for income tax purposes; or
- Student demonstrates total self-sufficiency.

Unusual circumstances that may be considered include:

- Legally granted refugee or asylum status;
- Parental abandonment or estrangement;
- Parental Incarceration;

Section 2: Reason for Appeal and Required Documentation:

If you have not already filed a FAFSA, you must complete the 2025-26 FAFSA providing only your information and selecting the option to submit your FAFSA without parent information or signature

Provide the following:

Required Documentation may include one or a combination of the following:

- A. Submission of a court order or official federal or state documentation that the parents or legal guardians are incarcerated
- B. A documented phone call or written statement, which confirms the unusual circumstances with

- a. a state, county, or tribal welfare agency;
- b. an independent living case worker who supports current and former foster youth with the transition to adulthood; or
- c. a public or private agency, facility, or program servicing the victims of abuse, neglect, assault, or violence
- C. A documented phone call or written statement from an attorney, guardian ad litem, a court-appointed special advocate (or similar), or a representative of a TRIO or GEAR UP program which confirms the circumstances and the person's relationship to the student; or
- D. Utility bills, health insurance, or other documents that demonstrate a separation from parents or legal guardians.
- E. A written statement from a third-party professional (such as a counselor, minister, attorney, educator, doctor, or social worker) that confirms or supports the claim of estrangement, abuse, abandonment, or the specific circumstances surrounding the current relationship with your parents.
- F. A written statement from a relative or friend that confirms or supports the claim of estrangement, abuse, abandonment, or the specific circumstances surrounding the current relationship with your parents.
- G. Any relevant supporting documentation corresponding with your specific circumstances:
- H. Death certificate, obituary, or funeral program;
- I. Documentation that verifies the parent is incarcerated and lists the parent's anticipated release date.

Appeals are reviewed once all required documentation is received and complete.
