


Naomi Garcia Suastegui




Riley Adams

Some of my favorite hobbies are crafting, baking, and listening to music. I'm looking forward to meeting you all and taking part in this program!








Aaron Menefee

I applied to be apart of the R.I.S.E Scholar Program since I wanted to be more engaged with UNLV since I want to have more involvement on campus and engage with the community.








Major: Urban Studies (Public Administration)


