SENATE BILL 55-16

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE UNDOCUMENTED STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is "empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN"; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate for the financial needs of undergraduate students through means of scholarships; AND

WHEREAS, the UNLV CSUN Scholarships and Grants Committee was donated \$40,000 in donations in order to be appropriated for scholarships and grants; **AND**

WHEREAS, after discussion and approval from committee members during S&G 55-03 funds have been approved for reallocation within the FY 2025 Organization Budget for an amount not to exceed \$6,000 from the donor fund; AND

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, CSUN shall appropriate \$16,000 one (1) time for the Undocumented

Student Scholarship for the 2024-2025 academic year, consisting of \$10,000 from the original scholarship amount and \$6,000 from the donor fund. This allocation will reflect the CSUN Scholarship program for the 2024-2025 academic year only. After the 2024-2025 academic year, the Undocumented Student Scholarship will revert to the original \$10,000 amount.

ADDENDUM A

The scholarship amount initially allocated for the UNLV UNDOCUMENTED STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP will be increased by \$6,000. The total funding for the program will now be \$16,000 for the 2024-2025 academic year, reflecting the added funds. These additional funds are to be used in accordance with the terms and conditions outlined in the original CSUN bylaws. The added \$6,000 will be disbursed in the same manner and timeline as the original funding. All other terms and conditions outlined in the original agreement remain in effect unless specifically amended in this addendum.
