AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CSUN SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI..D.01, is "empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN"; AND

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate for the needs of undergraduate student organizations; AND

WHEREAS, the student organization has completed all of the necessary documentation as required by the Ways and Means Committee and the Ways and Means Operating Policy; AND

WHEREAS, the \$34,000 is to be divided equally among the 16 remaining scholarships; AND

WHEREAS, after discussion and approval from committee members during S&G 55-04 funds have been approved for reallocation within the FY 2025 Organization Budget for an amount not to exceed \$34,000 from the donor fund; AND

WHEREAS, the 16 open scholarships Able Advancing, Adult Learner, APIME Community and Empowerment, Barbara Agonia Empowerment, College of Education Field Experience and Field Experience, Indigenous Community R.I.S.E Scholarship, International Student Scholarship, Justice for Black Lives Scholarship, LATINX Advocacy Scholarship, LGBTQIA+ Empowerment and Advocacy Scholarship, Pre-Professional Health Scholarship, Rebel Rebound Scholarship, Research Continuation

Scholarship, Study Abroad Scholarship, UNLV CSN Transfer Scholarship, Veterans and Military Families Scholarship, will be increased by \$2000, and \$2000 will be allocated to the CSUN Grants program; **AND**

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, that once this bill is passed through the Scholarship and Grants Committee, the CSUN Student Senate, and Signed by the CSUN Student Body President, these funds will be dispersed immediately to the 16 open scholarships and the CSUN Grants program.
