SENATE RESOLUTION 54-03

AN ACT TO SUPPORT AN INCREASE TO THE STUDENT TECHNOLOGY FEE

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; AND

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate and represent the needs of all undergraduate students; AND

WHEREAS, The Office of Information Technology is currently facing challenges to provide adequate customer service and maintain fully staff positions.

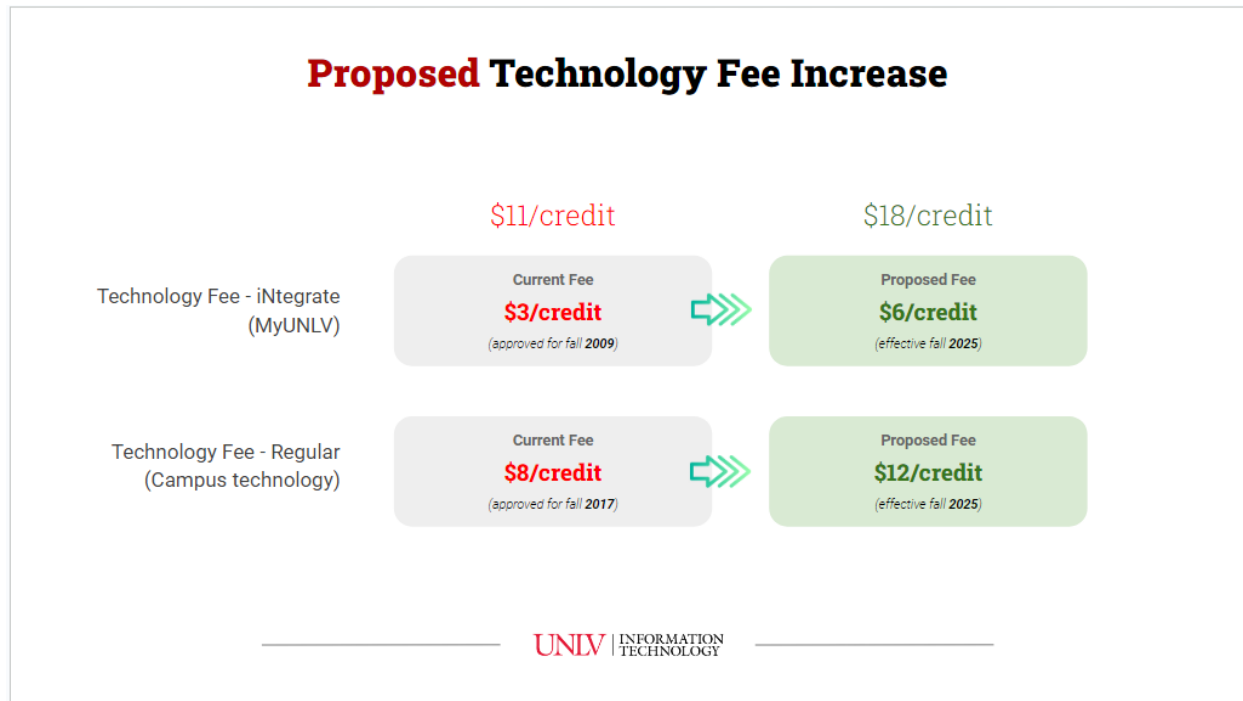
WHEREAS, The Office of Information Technology has not increased or revised their iNtegrate fee since Fall 2009 and their Regular Fee since Fall 2017. Yet, the costs associated and services provided with the Office of Information Technology continue to increase every year.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: The Consolidated Students of UNLV will support the increase of the Student Technology Fee in order to continue providing services and academic support to

undergraduate students.

LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED: The Consolidated Students of UNLV will support the increase of the iNtegrate Fee from \$3 per credit to \$6 per credit and the regular fee from \$8 per credit to \$12 per credit. Which will both take effect in Fall 2025.
