SENATE RESOLUTION 54-02

AN ACT TO SUPPORT AN INCREASE TO THE ACADEMIC SUCCESS CENTER FEE

Resolution Number: SR 54-02

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; AND

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate and represent the needs of all undergraduate students; AND

WHEREAS, The Academic Success Center is currently facing challenges to maintain leading-edge academic support, segmented care, and services for all students inside and outside of the classroom due to the current fee.

WHEREAS, The Academic Success Center has not increased or revised their fee since 2013. Yet, the costs associated and services provided with the Academic Success Center continue to increase every year under Addendum A.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: The Consolidated Students of UNLV will support the increase of the Academic Success Center Fee in order to continue providing services and academic support to undergraduate students.

LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED: The Consolidated Students of UNLV will support the increase of the fee that will increase from \$25 per semester to \$50 per semester that will take effect in Fall 2025.

Addendum A

The Proposal

- This fee was originally approved at the December 2013 Board of Regents meeting as a \$25 per semester and per undergraduate student enrolled in one or more credits fee to replace the \$1/credit allocation for the Academic Success Center.
- It has not been revised or increased since 2013 We are proposing changing the fee to \$50 per student, per semester effective Fall 2025. If it advances, it will go to the Board of Regents at the December 2024 meeting.
