Notes

- Requirements for the certificate in Spanish Language include 18 credit hours in the discipline.
- Must have an overall 2.0 GPA or higher in Spanish courses.
- At least 9 credits must be earned at UNLV.
- Any student placed above SPAN 213 will take additional Linguistics and Literature courses to complete 18 credits of SPAN.
- Heritage speakers who grew up speaking Spanish may not take SPAN 213, SPAN 214, or SPAN 301. Instead, they
 take SPAN 226, SPAN 227, and SPAN 302. They take three Linguistics and Literature elective courses for a total
 of 18 credits of SPAN coursework.
